## SANTA FE SCOTTISH RITE CENTER Mobility Challenged & Handicapped Access

The Santa Fe Scottish Rite is a privately owned building that was built prior to the American's With Disabilities Act. While the Santa Fe Scottish Rite is not required to have Handicapped Entrances, we will make all efforts to assist Mobility Challenged Individuals when entering or exiting the building for events. Scottish Rite Stewards and/or Event Personnel are available to assist patrons.

## **Theater**

There is an outside entrance on the westside alcove of the building. The door is labelled Green Room/Handicapped Access. This door is kept locked for security reasons so if a guest wants access to the theater, they can make arrangements entry by calling:

Vehicles may park temporarily just outside the door for drop off & pickup but please pullover to allow others into our parking lot. For pickup guests can find a Scottish Rite Steward or call the numbers above for an escort & assistance to the exit door. We have several new dedicated "Handicapped" parking spaces. At the entrance to our driveway on Paseo de Peralta on the westside of our building there is a Handicapped Van parking space & a single Handicapped parking space. In our upper parking lot along the southside next to the wire fence we have four single Handicapped parking spaces and a fifth space for Mobility Challenged vehicle.
