The new men are, in fact, their actual boyfriends, Ferrando and Guglielmo, in disguise. Don Alfonso bribes Despina, the high-powered, capitalist-motivated "momager" of the sisters, to join in on the plot. Chaos ensues as the new beaus are introduced to the sisters.

He enlists the help of Dr. Malatesta to find a suitable match. Malatesta recommends his docile "sister" (Norina in disguise). After a fictitious wedding, the docile "sister" becomes a spitfire. She goes on a shopping spree and, declaring she is going to the theatre, slaps Pasquale. As she leaves, she drops a note ... the final part of the plan to change Pasquale's mind about the nephew's wedding.
